

AY2027 Application Guidelines for

Rikkyo Promising Future Scholarship (RPFS)

NEXUS/PEACE Enrollees in AY2027 through Assessment System

Based on Recommendation from School Principal

1. Objective

The Rikkyo Promising Future Scholarship (RPFS), for which eligibility is determined at the time of application, aims at excellent privately financed international students from various regions and countries who display a strong desire to study at Rikkyo University, thereby welcoming excellent international students from various regions and countries across the world, contributing to the further internationalization of Rikkyo, and nurturing students to use their studies at Rikkyo to play an active international role in their future careers.

2. Student Eligible for the RPFS

The subject of the RPFS shall be those students who enroll in through the assessment system based on a recommendation from a school principal.

- **NEXUS students to be enrolled in September** belonging to the Colleges of: Arts, Economics, Sociology, Law and Politics, Community and Human Services, Business, Contemporary Psychology, Intercultural Communication, Sport and Wellness, and Environmental Studies.

- **PEACE students to be enrolled in April and September** belonging to the College of Law and Politics, College of Intercultural Communication, and the Global Liberal Arts Program.

3. Scholarship Amount, Payment Method and Period

Award Amount

【April enrollment】*PEACE Students Only

Amount equivalent to tuition and other fees (EXCLUDING the admission fee) for the first 2 consecutive semesters

【September enrollment】

Amount equivalent to tuition and other fees (EXCLUDING the admission fee) for the first 3 consecutive semesters

Payment Method

Automatically deducted from the required fees by semester

Payment Period

【April enrollment】*PEACE Students Only

1 year (2 consecutive semesters)

【September enrollment】

1.5 years (3 consecutive semesters)

4. Number of Recipients

Approximately 20 students/AY (enrollees through assessment system based on recommendation from school principal)

5. Application Eligibility and Requirements

- (1) Students who have or will have the “Student” status of residence at the time of enrollment.
- (2) Students accepted for enrollment to Rikkyo through the assessment system based on a recommendation from a school principal.
- (3) It is not approved to receive the RPFS at the same time as any other scholarships from Rikkyo University (except for the Rikkyo University Global Scholarship).

6. Applications

An applicant for the Scholarship shall apply through the online application system at the time of application for NEXUS and PEACE programs.

7. Selection and Determination of Prospective Recipients

Prospective recipients shall be selected from among applicants who have successfully passed the admissions assessment process.

8. Announcements

Prospective recipients shall be notified of the awarding of the RPFS through the online application system at the time they are notified of acceptance into Rikkyo.

9. Important Notices

- In the light of the spirit of the scholarship, the recipients of the scholarship shall endeavor in their study at Rikkyo and complete their courses, while serving as a good role model for others.
- The scholarship shall be withdrawn in the event that it transpires that a recipient does not have the “Student” status of residence after enrollment in principle. In that case, the recipient must return the amounts covered by the scholarship.
- The scholarship shall not be paid for semesters in which a student takes a leave of absence. Also, payment of the scholarship may be suspended when it is recognized that circumstances have arisen in which it is not appropriate to award the scholarship, such as the recipient abandoning their studies at Rikkyo.
- A recipient shall forfeit eligibility to receive the scholarship, when they are subject to withdrawal or expulsion from Rikkyo, or, when it is deemed appropriate to disqualify them from receiving the scholarship due to suspension from classes or disciplinary action, etc.

Application Schedule 1 for PEACE applicants to be enrolled in April, 2027

RPFS application period	November 6, 2026 to November 20, 2026	Apply for the RPFS through the online application system during the application period for NEXUS and PEACE programs.
Announcement of selection results	January 15, 2027	To be announced through the online application system at the time of notification of acceptance into Rikkyo

Application Schedule 2 for NEXUS/PEACE applicants to be enrolled in September, 2027

RPFS application period	January 18, 2027 to February 1, 2027	Apply for the RPFS through the online application system during the application period for NEXUS and PEACE programs.
Announcement of selection results	March 5, 2027	To be announced through the online application system at the time of notification of acceptance into Rikkyo
